St. Patrick's Day Parade

For 1 to 4 players

How to play

The youngest player starts and then move clockwise to the next player.

The dice determines how many places to move and in which direction.

If a player lands on a Shamrock, they are safe and cannot be moved by another player.

If a player lands on a Leprechaun, they miss the next turn.

When a player lands on a spot with another player already there, then that player is moved backwards to the next vacant spot.

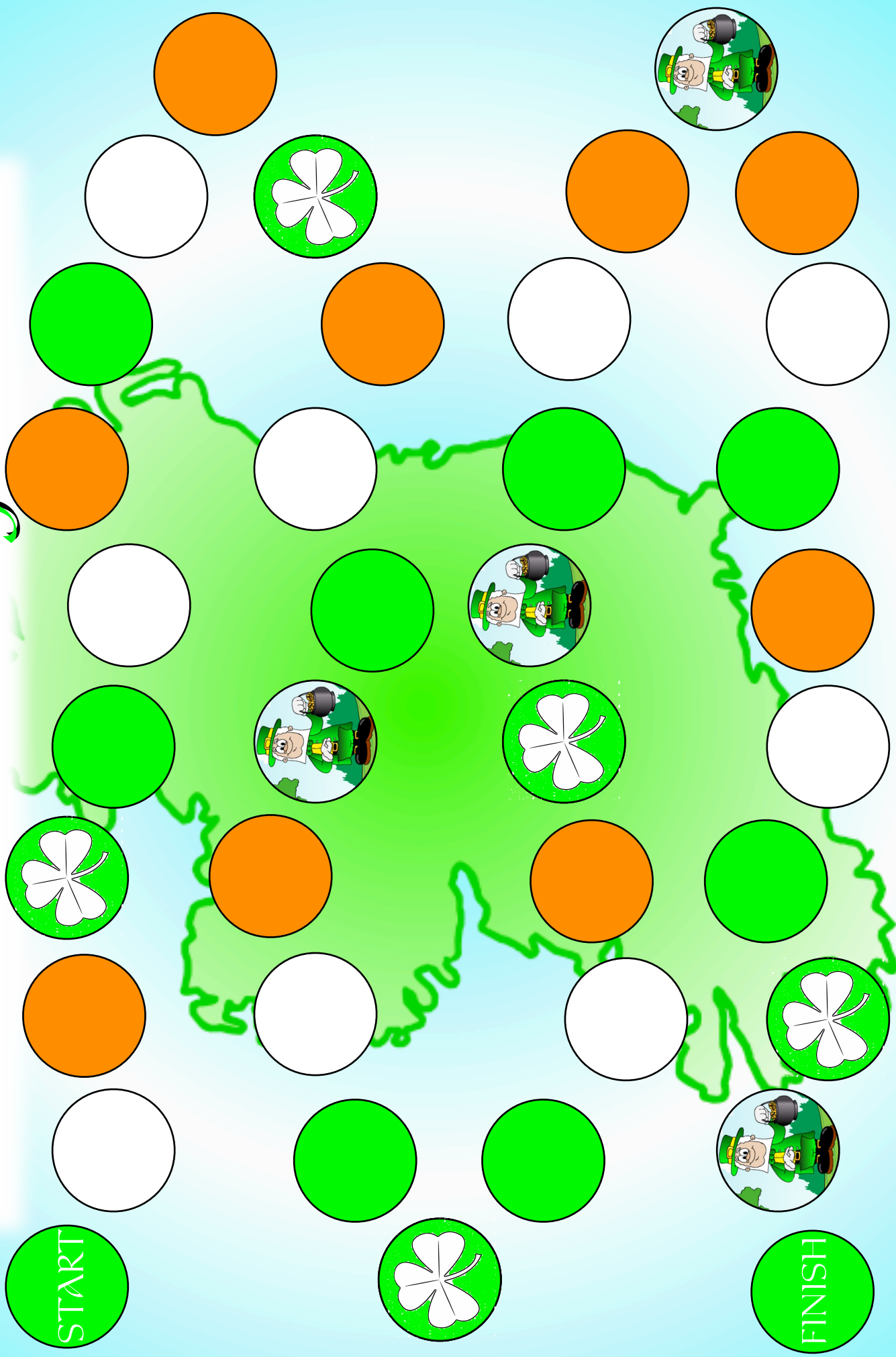
However, if the spot is a Shamrock, then that player must go back to their original spot (where they were before the dice was thrown).

If the spot is a Leprechaun, then the player who occupied the spot moves back to the next vacant spot and the player who threw the dice takes the Leprechaun spot and misses the next turn.

To win a player must throw the number needed to land on the “Finish” spot.

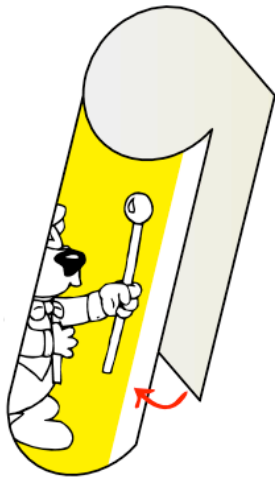
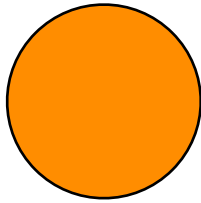
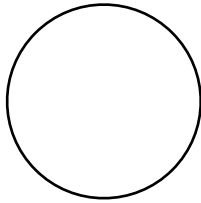
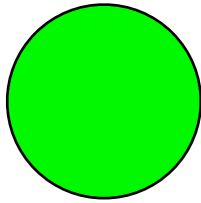

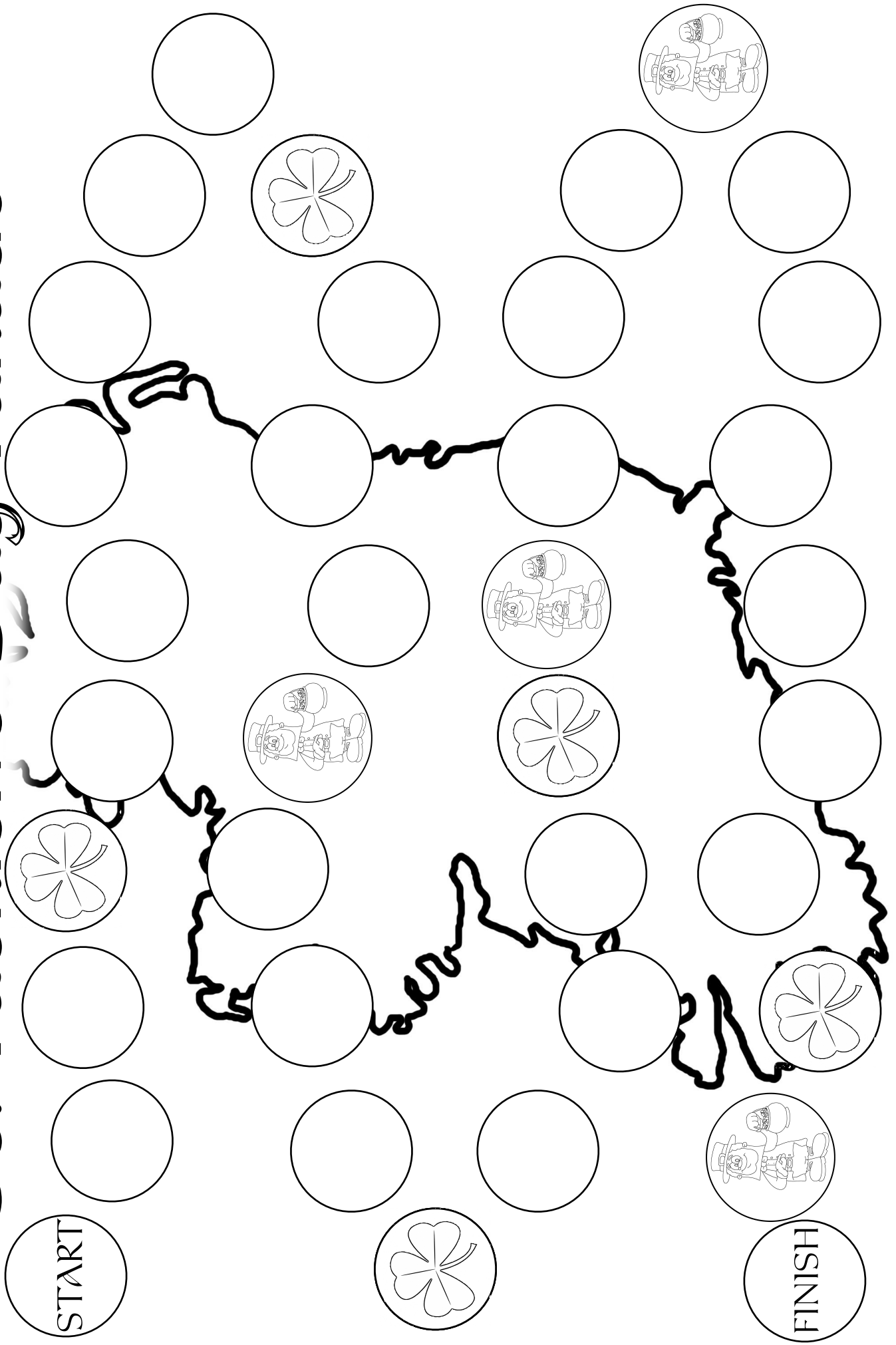


Cut along the dotted lines.

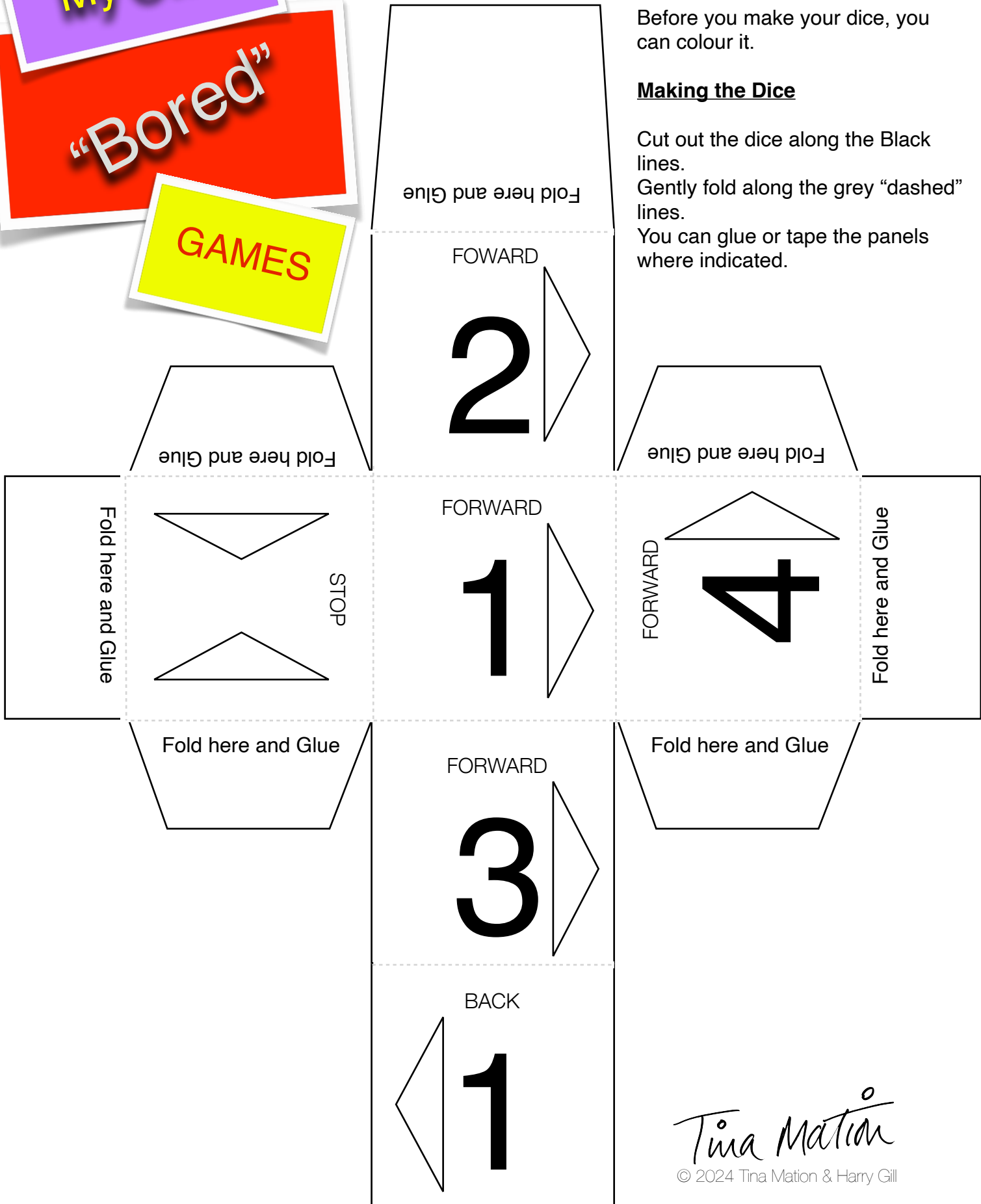
Before you make your dice, you can colour it.
